LATINARTE OUR ROOTS

1. Contestants

- -All people of Latin American origin, adults and high school students, residents of Utah and Western Wyoming may participate.
- -Employees of the Mexican Consulate in Salt Lake City and members of Artes de Mexico en Utah may not participate.

2. Artwork

Those interested may compete with an original work in any of the following artistic branches: drawing, painting, sculpture, photography, mixed techniques, ceramics and engraving. The work must not exceed the following measurements:

- -Two-dimensional works, no larger than 34" wide by 82" high (86cm x 2m high)
- -Three-dimensional works (Example: sculptures) no larger than 34" wide by 82" high (86cm x 86cm x 2m)

3. Artwork pictures:

- -Send 3 color photographs, resolution of 600 pixels, JPEG format.
- -Only one work per applicant will be accepted.

 - Curriculum Vitae, Resume, or Biography of the participant, no more than one page
- Written proposal that includes a brief description of the work, no more than one descriptive paragraph per work.
